June 22-26, 2010 is Service Week at NPC. We are offering several service opportunities for students in grades 5-12. Please read through the various opportunities and prayerfully consider where might be the best place for you to serve. Students must **apply** to be considered for this program and attached is an application to participate in this week of service. Completed applications are due to the Student Ministries office by **May 2**. The application must be completely filled out and **signed by both parents and students**. - **Youth Evening Service (YES)**- This is a *new program* that will run the same time as the Children's evening VBS (Sunday June 20, then Tuesday June 22 through Friday June 25). Every evening we will have a service project that may involve supporting Children's VBS, going to serve at a local mission partner, and/or working to prepare resources for our existing ministries. We will also have a devotional time where we will learn more about God's Word for us. Every evening we will have dinner, make new friends, and have some FUN while serving our Savior!
- **CIT (Counselor in Training)** - Current 5th graders ready to serve the children in VBS have an incredible opportunity to model Christ's love and service during **morning** VBS. Students in CIT will need to attend a mandatory training session either Sunday, May 23 at 11:30 or Friday, June 4 at 4:00.
- **VBS Volunteer**- Students grades 6-12 are invited to apply to serve within the children's VBS morning or evening program. There are a variety of opportunities such as crew leaders and assistant crew leaders, station leaders/helpers, meal preparation, skits, music, and many other opportunities.
