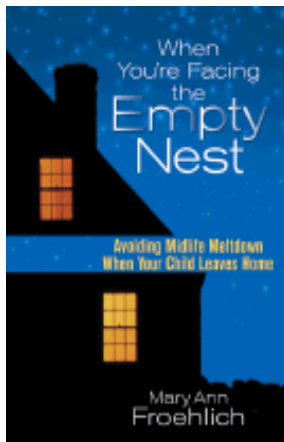


The Moms of Teens Book Group

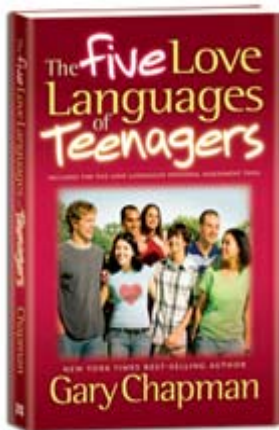
Begins on October 15th and will meet in the SHAC at NPC on Wednesday mornings from 9:30-11:00.
